

Naturalization Ceremony - Missouri State University, Springfield, MO

Parking & Shuttle Service for Applicants and their Guests

- Parking for ceremony applicants and their guests is located in Parking Lots 51 & 52 at the southeast intersection of **Kimbrough Ave. and Walnut St.**, Springfield, MO. These are Missouri State University (MSU) parking lots.
- Available from **7:30am-1:00pm**, two dedicated shuttles will be in continuous operation to transport applicants and their guests to/from parking lots 51 & 52 to the actual ceremony location. Shuttles are handicap accessible.
A Welcome Tent will be located in the parking area to assist with shuttle boarding and questions.
- Naturalization Ceremony location is at the Plaster Student Union on the campus of Missouri State University.

Traveling I-44 East or West or Hwy 13 South

- From I-44, exit at Kansas Expressway.
(Hwy 13 South into Springfield turns into Kansas Expressway)
- Turn south onto Kansas Expressway.
- Turn left (east) at Chestnut Expressway.
- Turn right (south) at Benton Ave.
Once over the bridge, Benton Ave. turns into Kimbrough St.
- The 3rd stoplight will be Kimbrough & Walnut St.

Traveling north to Springfield

- From James River Freeway, exit to Glenstone north.
- Turn left (west) on Grand Ave.
- Turn right (north) on Kimbrough Ave.
Follow Kimbrough to Walnut St.
(4th stoplight) Parking will be on the right.
